Japanese Film Festival 2017

The Japan Foundation and the Embassy of Japan, in cooperation with the Ministry of Culture and Fine Arts and Cambodia-Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC) will organize the "Japanese Film Festival in Cambodia 2017" from 9 to 12 November 2017, at the Major Cineplex (AEON Mall), Legend Cinema (TK Avenue) in Phnom Penh.

During the four-day, Japanese films selected from a wide range of different categories will be screened at the above-mentioned major theaters in Phnom Penh. As the selection includes cartoon, drama, documentary films and some of which are awarded-winning films, with these film portraying various aspects of Japanese life, society and culture, the Festival will provide a good opportunity for audience to familiarize themselves with Japan and its people.
