Tour for the promotion of Japanese Language and Culture in Cambodia

Japanese language teachers and students are going to visit 15 high schools in Cambodia from 3 to 24 December 2016, and showcase Japanese language and culture to students in Phnom Penh and provinces.

They will conduct activities such as quiz games about Japan, Japanese language trial lessons, sessions for wearing Japanese traditional clothes and experiencing *Origami*, and sharing their experience of study in Japan with the students.

The program is implemented in cooperation with the Japanese Language Department of the Institute of Foreign Language of the Royal University of Phnom Penh (RUPP), the Education and Research Center for Japanese Law (CJL) and the Japanese Language course in the Royal University of Economics and Law (RULE), the Mekong School of Japanese at the Cambodian Mekong University (CMU) and the Cambodia-Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC).

This program aims to provide an opportunity for young Cambodian students to experience Japanese language and culture in their home towns. Cambodian youths who cannot easily participate in Japanese cultural events in the capital will be able to deepen their understanding of Japan, which will strengthen ties of friendship between Cambodia and Japan.
