It is a great pleasure for me to hold this signing ceremony of Japan's Grant Assistance for the improving drainage system and road of Sangkae Pi Commune, Chhaeb District in Preah Vihear Province.

First of all, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to H.E. Mr. OUM Mara, Governor of Preah Vihear Province to attend this ceremony.

This project, which amounts to \$100,973, aims to improve the access to social infrastructure such as school, health center and market in Sangkae Pi Commune in Preah Vihear Province by installment of two culverts and rehabilitation of 4,000m laterite road. Local residents currently use floaters to cross flooded river and spend several hours to access social infrastructure in rainy season. This project is expected to improve flood management as well as safety environment in the area and to benefit nearly 1,500 people.

Transportation sector is vital for the economic and social development of Cambodia, and the Cambodian Government has continuously made efforts for the improvement in this sector.
