WHAT'S KUSANONE?

KUSANONE Grant provides grant assistance to implement development projects at the grass-roots level. In 2003, the term "Human Security" was added, to adopt the concept of:

- not only empowering individuals and communities to be self-reliant
- but also protecting people from a wide range of factors that directly threaten the lives, livelihoods, and dignity of human beings.

The grant amount is up to 10 million Japanese Yen for each project.

The costs to be covered include the purchase or construction of facilities, equipment.


The following items CAN NOT be financed:

- Administrative costs of the recipient organization such as office rent and staff salaries,
- Running and maintenance costs of facilities and equipment,
- Items which would belong to individuals,
- Articles of consumption and small equipment,
- Books and PCs (personal computers),
- Vehicle, Land, Tax and Bank charge.

•••• Eligible Applicants

★NGOs

- (Individuals and Profit Associations are NOT eligible)
- ★Local Government
- (Central Government is NOT eligible)
- *Other non-profit associations
- such as hospitals and primary schools
- # Must have at least 2 years working experience in the sector.
- # Also required to demonstrate its ability as well as its past experience to manage finance, personnel, and projects.


