Eligibility

No restriction on age, sex, occupation, but only Cambodian Nationality.

Deadline for submitting entries

November 13, 2018 (Tuesday)

(Note) The work itself will be submitted on the day of the event.

Selection

Entries will be carefully judged by the executive committee of the Phnom Penh Clean City Challenge with Japan, and three winners of Recycle Art/Craft Work competition will be selected.
