# Guideline for The 2019 “Nodojiman” Japanese Song Contest

## Competition’s outline

- This Contest is a school competition. Representatives of Japanese language school or university are required to ask the students’ intention and should consider to apply for participating in this contest from your schools.
- The number of participants (or groups) from each school will be decided by the number of final applicants and the number of students in each school.
- The Karaoke music for the contest is required to be prepared by participants or schools and submit it to the Embassy in advance.
- This contest does not arrange a Karaoke machine, hence participants need to memorize the lyrics.

Rehearsal Time: 8:00 – 9:00

Contest Time: 9:30 – 12:00

The contest is held at CJCC during the Tanabata Festival (Star Festival) on 13 & 14 July 2019.
