## Guideline of the application for MEXT Scholarship for 2020 in Cambodia

22 April 2019

Embassy of Japan in Cambodia

The Embassy will apply this guideline to the application for MEXT Scholarship for 2020 in Cambodia in addition to the basic Application Guidelines by MEXT.

### 1. Requirement of transcript

In addition to the requirements which are provided in the basic Application Guidelines by MEXT, the Embassy of Japan sets the requirement of transcript as follows;

### (a) Research Students

- > 7 grades or higher out of 10 grades of cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA)
  (average from first year to final year) in the last university or graduate school
  attended
- > The transcript which candidates are required to submit at the application and the Embassy uses to judge the requirement of transcript are as follows.

The Embassy does not allow high school students who are currently in the year of grade 11 to apply for College of Technology Students in Cambodia.

  - Candidates do not fulfill all the requirements.
  - Candidates do not submit all the necessary documents.

  - Candidates do not submit documents which fulfill all the requirements.
