- Multiple-entry visa: Validity period is up to 3 years (first request; valid for 1 year), and the maximum for each stay is 90 days.

The examination will be based on the travelling history to Japan, marriage status, etc. Please understand that as a result of the examination, there may be cases where requested visa will not be granted.
