

Single-entry visa for long-term stay purpose
(Training, working, student, spouse of Japanese etc.)

When an application for visa is made for the purpose such as employment, residency, etc. in Japan, it is necessary for a proxy in Japan to obtain the “Certificate of Eligibility” and for the visa applicant to file a visa application at the Embassy or Consular Office in Siem Reap by submitting the following documents.

******In order to obtain the Certificate of Eligibility, a proxy in Japan should make an application with the nearest Regional Immigration Bureau of the Immigration services Agency to the proxy’s place of residence in Japan. (An application for Certificate of Eligibility cannot be made at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.)

	Documents	Remarks
①	Valid passport (Original)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No significant stain or damage• Should have at least 2 blank pages for VISA.
②	VISA application with 1 photo affixed (Original)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Taken within the last 6 months (H:4.5cm x W:3.5cm, White background, B/W or color photo)• Fill "N/A" in the column that does not apply to the applicant.
③	Copy of Certificate of Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Original document is no longer required.• A copy of the email if it was delivered electronically.• A COE copy can be made in B/W or in color. (Only a copy of the front side is acceptable, if there are no special note written at the backside)

- ① If it becomes necessary to confirm with Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan (in Tokyo) or relevant organizations during the examination process, the examination period may exceed one month.
- ② During the visa examination process, the applicant may be requested to submit additional documents or attend an interview.
