Main duties and responsibilities

The assistant is responsible for 1) monitoring and summarizing news and unclassified information, 2) attending meetings or press conferences with or on behalf of Japanese staff, 3) assisting information collection and analysis work by the Embassy, and other assignments, including translation for the Japanese staffs and filing.

Minimum qualification

- Cambodian national
- At least five years of working experience (preferably)
- A Bachelor degree
- Fluent in both spoken and written English. Knowledge of Japanese, Chinese and/or French languages is an advantage.
