

Participation in the Southeast Asia Biosphere Reserves Network Meeting by Mr. Yonezawa, Director of the Consular Office of Japan in Siem Reap

On 7 April, the 16th Southeast Asia Biosphere Reserves Network (SeaBRnet) Meeting was held in Siem Reap. Mr. Yonezawa, Director of the Consular Office of Japan in Siem Reap, attended the opening ceremony together with H.E. Mr. Chea Sam Ang, Secretary of State of the Ministry of Environment. SeaBRnet is a collaborative platform aimed at conserving biosphere reserves in Southeast Asia under UNESCO's "Man and the Biosphere (MAB)" program, and is supported by the Government of Japan. Director Yonezawa expressed his hope that the meeting would further advance regional cooperation toward the conservation of biosphere reserves in Southeast Asia, including the Tonle Sap biosphere reserve.
