**JENESYS 2016 Youth Exchange Program  
(1<sup>st</sup> Group)**

23 Cambodian high school students are going to visit Japan from 18 to 25 October at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2016.

The JENESYS 2016 aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and regions and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation.

The students will visit Tokyo and Hokkaido Prefecture to participate in exchange programs with related institutions under the theme of “Science and Technology”. They will have opportunities to visit the National Museum of Emerging Science and Innovation (Miraikan), the Sapporo Science Center and the Science Education Center attached to the Hokkaido University to see Japanese cutting-edge technology as well as take part in a school exchange program with the Hokkaido Sapporo Intercultural and Technology High School. The detailed schedule is attached herewith.

It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of Japan and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
