JENESYS 2016 Youth Exchange Program (Theme: Economics, 3rd Group)

21 Cambodian youths who are interested in the field of Economics are going to visit Japan from 25 October to 1 November with youths from other ASEAN countries, Timor-Leste and India at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2016.

The JENESYS 2016 aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and regions and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation.

The youths will visit Tokyo and Gunma Prefecture to participate in exchange programs with various institutions and companies under the sub-theme of "ICT related to logistics". They will also have opportunities to visit the Tomioka Silk Mill which was registered on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2014, and experience a home stay and Japanese culture. The detailed schedule is attached herewith.

It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of economic relations between Japan and the other countries, and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
