**JENESYS 2016 Youth Exchange Program  
(Economics, Group 4: Fisheries)**

22 Cambodian youths who are interested in the field of Fisheries are going to visit Japan from 29 November to 6 December with youths from other ASEAN countries, Timor-Leste and India at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2016.

The youths will visit Wakayama prefecture to participate in exchange programs with various institutions and companies related to Fisheries. They will also have opportunities to visit the Wakayama Castle which is one of the most famous castles in Japan, and experience a home stay. The detailed schedule is attached herewith.

The JENESYS aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and regions and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation. Through the program, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has invited more than 2,000 Cambodian youths since 2007.

It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of Japan and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
