JENESYS 2016 Youth Exchange Program (Theme: Economics, 1st Group)

22 Cambodian youths who are interested in the field of Economics are going to visit Japan from 28 August to 6 September with youths from other ASEAN countries, Timor-Leste and India at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2016.

The JENESYS 2016 aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and regions and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation.

The youth being invited from 28 August will visit Osaka, Kyoto, Shiga and Miyagi Prefectures in separate groups in order to participate in exchange programs with various institutions and companies under the sub-theme of "Economic Partnership, Trade and Investment". They will also have opportunities to visit historic buildings and the National Museum of Emerging Science and Innovation as well as experience a home stay and Japanese Culture. It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of economic relations between Japan and the other countries, and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
