Preliminary in-country contest in Cambodia

12 September, 2016

The preliminary in-country contest in Cambodia for the "Asian International Children's Film Festival 2016" was successfully held on 12 September, 2016 at the Cambodia-Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC).

This preliminary contest was organized by the Embassy of Japan in Cambodia in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport and the CJCC. The theme of this year was "My hateful thing". 46 films were submitted by high school students in Cambodia, and 16 films were pre-selected and screened at the contest.

The Festival was started in Japan in 2007, and since then it has been organized every year. Cambodian students have been invited to the Festival since 2009. This year, 9 Students of the 3 winning groups will be invited to Japan under the JENESYS "Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths" 2016 Program, along with students from 10 ASEAN countries (Cambodia, Indonesia, Singapore, Thailand, the Philippines, Laos, Myanmar, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia), East Timor, China, South Korea, Mongolia, and Chinese Taipei, and Japan. They will participate in the final round of the Festival in Kitami City, Hokkaido, Japan on November 26, 2016.
