2017 Spring Conferment of Decoration Mr. Koji Kanzaki

On 29th April, the Cabinet Office, the Government of Japan, announced the recipients of the 2017 Spring Conferment of Decorations, which are bestowed upon individuals of merit in recognition of their national or public services, and in honour of their distinguished accomplishments in various areas in society. Mr. Koji Kanzaki is one of the 4,080 recipients and he received the Order of the Rising Sun, Gold and Silver Rays for his contribution to promotion of mutual understanding between Japan and Cambodia.
