**JENESYS 2016 Youth Exchange Program
(Economics, Group 9: Environmental Business)**

14 Cambodian youths are going to visit Japan from 15 to 23 May with youths from other ASEAN countries and Timor-Leste at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2016.

After visiting Tokyo, the participants will visit Fukuoka prefecture to participate in exchange programs with various institutions and companies related to the theme of “Environmental Business”. They will also have an opportunity to visit historical landmarks. The detailed schedule is attached herewith.

The JENESYS aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation. Through the program, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has invited more than 2,000 Cambodian youths since 2007.

It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of Japan and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
