The Competition for participating JENESYS 2017 Youth Exchange Program to Japan

The Embassy of Japan is pleased to announce that the Embassy, in cooperation with the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sport and the Cambodia-Japan Cooperation Center (CJCC), is going to conduct a selection of participants for a youth exchange program "JENESYS 2017" to be held from 15 to 23 January 2018 in Japan. Through the competition of the group presentation, the Embassy will select 24 students from all the 3rd academic year student of universities in Cambodia regardless of their major subject.

Every 3rd-year student, who is willing to join the program, is able to submit the application in group of 4 students until 7 September. On 28 September, the Embassy will announce the selected 48 students (12 groups) for the final selection on 5 October, 2017, at CJCC. The final selection will be competed by the uniqueness, attractiveness and team-work of each group presentation under the theme of "**My Best Cambodia**" in Khmer.

The JENESYS is a youth exchange program organized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation. Through the program, the Ministry has invited more than 2,000 Cambodian youths since 2007.
