JENESYS 2017 Youth Exchange Program (Japan-ASEAN Students Conference)

12 Cambodian youths are going to visit Japan from 18 to 26 September with youths from other ASEAN countries at the invitation of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan under the JENESYS (Japan-East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youth) 2017.

After visiting Tokyo, the participants are separated into each theme group and visit Iwate, Miyagi, Fukuoka or Kumamoto prefecture to participate in the Japan-ASEAN Students Conference and other exchange programs with various institutions and companies related to each theme. They will also have an opportunity to visit historical landmarks. The detailed schedule is attached herewith.

The JENESYS aims to promote mutual trust and understanding among the people of Japan and participating countries and to build a basis for future friendship and cooperation. Through the program, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs has invited more than 2,000 Cambodian youths since 2007.

It is expected that the participants will deepen their understanding of Japan and after coming back, share their experience widely with the people in Cambodia.
