It is a great pleasure for me to sign a contract with Cheung Prey-Batheay Operational District for Grass-roots Human Security Project today.

The Grant Assistance of USD 92,290 is provided for installing medical equipment in Cheung Prey Referral Hospital in Kampong Cham Province.

Based on the request made by Cheung Prey-Batheay Operational District and the field survey conducted by Embassy's staff, we recognized the urgent need of medical equipment for the operating room in Cheung Prey Referral Hospital in order to improve emergency medical services and surgical operations.
